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**To register your independent travel in MyWorld, please read through the directions below and let me know if you have any questions:**

1. Log-in to your MyWorld application through the UNL Education Abroad website.
2. Find the first heading of your application - "Application Instructions" in blue. Read through the information listed under "Registering independent travel."
3. Find the heading to the left labeled "Itinerary." Click on the button "add new itinerary record."
4. Please follow these steps in order to register your independent travel in MyWorld:
  - Start and End Dates: Choose your departure and return dates of independent travel.
  - Location: Where are you going? Highlight the city and country. If you do not find your specific city, please choose a larger city that is the closest to your travel destination.
  - Click "add" to add your travel itinerary to your MyWorld application.
5. Once complete, please log-out of MyWorld. There is not a limit as to the number of "itineraries" you can add to your MyWorld application.
